

PRIVACY STATEMENT

ProJoules BV respects the privacy of visitors to the Website, in particular the rights of visitors in relation to the automated processing of personal data. In order to be fully transparent with our customers, we have therefore formulated and implemented a policy regarding these processing operations themselves, their purpose and the possibilities for those involved to exercise their rights as best as possible.

Article 1 - Legal provisions

1. Website (hereinafter also referred to as "the Website"): ProJoules.com

Article 2 - Access to the website

Article 3 - The content of the website

All company data which the customer places in ProJoules always remains the property of the customer.

All data that a customer places in ProJoules.com always remains the property of the customer. ProJoules BV will never use the cultivation information shared on ProJoules.com by the customer or share it with third parties unless access is explicitly given by the customer, for example to provide technical support.

Article 7 - Your rights in relation to your data

Pursuant to Article 13(2)(b) of the AVG, everyone has the right to access, rectify or erase personal data concerning them or to restrict the processing thereof, as well as the right to object to the processing and the right to data portability. Any such request must be accompanied by a copy of a valid identity document, on which you have affixed your signature, and by the address at which you can be contacted. You will receive a reply to your request within 1 month of submitting it. Depending on the complexity and the number of requests, this period may be extended by 2 months if necessary.

Article 8 - Processing of personal data

In the event of a violation of any laws or regulations, of which the visitor is suspected and for which the authorities need personal data collected by the administrator, these will be provided to them following an explicit and reasoned request by those authorities, after which this personal data will no longer fall under the protection of the provisions of this Privacy Statement.
